Public school teachers have voted to boycott NAPLAN tests unless the Govt bans the creation of league tables. Parents are backing a national boycott of national numeracy and literacy tests at public schools. Teachers voted this morning not to hold the exams for primary and secondary students. Angelo Gavrielatos, Austn Education Union, says the Union can't support the misuse of data, if the results are published on the Fed Govts My School website. The Federal Opposition is against teachers boycotting numeracy and literacy testing, but understands the frustration. Delegates from the Education Union have voted not to administer the tests in May, if the Government proceeds in using the results to rank schools. Opposition Education Spokesman Christopher Pyne says the Government is publicising problems in schools, but not solving them. The **Qld** Teachers Union says teachers may refuse to hand out the tests, but unions will make a final decision in April. **Qld** president Steve Ryan warns this will impact all schools in **Qld**. The **Qld Independent Education Union** is still considering the issue.
