Hundreds of Catholic teachers are striking for better pay. Catholic teachers say they are among the lowest paid in Aust and are refusing a 12.5% pay rise over three years. **Terry Burke, Independent Education Union** says that they are looking for another pay rise which is a little bit over a \$thousand more. Mike Byrne, Catholic Education Commission says the offer that they have put on the table for Catholic teachers is a good offer. Seven Catholic schools were forced to close, more than 30 others cancelled classes and many extra curriculum activities are now in jeopardy.
