Hinchliffe discusses the strike action taken yesterday by Catholic school teachers in the region. She is joined on the line by Richard Pascoe, Organiser, [Qld Independent Education Union](#), who says at meetings yesterday, members of the union expressed disappointment at the offer being put forth by their employers. Pascoe says the deal places 'onerous' demands on teachers to achieve wage increases in excess to senior levels, and that the union is calling on employers to reconsider their current position. He says the union will be meeting with employers next week, which he says will show if the employers are willing to negotiate, or if they will continue to 'hide behind their special relationship' with the [Qld State Govt](#). Pascoe says members will continue to meet, and will consider undertaking further work stoppages in the future to ensure that a better offer comes forth. He says teachers in independent schools are earning \$7,000 less per year than their counterparts in other states.
